There are several levels of multi-use golf passes each having a different maximum number of rounds of golf. The higher the maximum number of rounds, the lower the average cost per round assuming all rounds are used. The multi-use golf passes are not issued with a dollar amount, do not have a cash equivalent and cannot be used for any goods or services other than the number of rounds of golf indicated. They are valid for play only during the golf season in which they are purchased. In Alberta, the Gift Card Regulation passed under the Fair Trading Act prohibits expiry dates only for 'prepaid purchase cards'. A prepaid purchase card is a card or other payment device with a monetary value that is purchased or loaded on a prepaid basis in a specific amount for the future purchase of goods or services. It can be used as a cash equivalent when presented to the supplier. As the multi-use golf passes do not have a monetary value, are not issued in a specific amount, cannot be used as a cash equivalent and are sold only for a specific service they do not meet the definition of a prepaid purchase card as set out in the legislation. Therefore they may be issued with an expiry date. The Broadmoor Public Golf Course also provides for the sale gift cards with a specific monetary value that can be used as a cash equivalent for goods and services at the Course. These do meet the definition of prepaid purchase cards under the legislation and accordingly do not have an expiry date. Additionally, from a customer service perspective, the Broadmoor has ensured due diligence when it comes to communicating the expiring prior to purchase. The pass expiry is promoted on the webpage, in all print materials and the ProShop staff verbally speak to it prior to purchase so those who choose to buy the multi-play packs are well informed. The passes are also transferrable to make it easier for golfers to use up any unused rounds prior to expiration.	Complete
