

BYLAW 49-2016

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE MEETING PROCEDURES BYLAW, BYLAW 20-2015

Amendment No. 1

WHEREAS:

Sections 145 and 191 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c M-26, permits Council to pass bylaws to establish procedures for Council, Council committees, and other bodies established by Council;

Council enacted Bylaw 20-2015 to establish meeting procedures for Council;

THE COUNCIL OF STRATHCONA COUNTY THEREFORE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Bylaw 20-2015 is amended by this bylaw.
- 2 Section 2.26.1 is added:
 - 2.26.1 "Substantive Motion" is a motion put on the floor to deal with Council's business matters but does not include motions relating to procedural matters such as adjournments, points of procedure, points of privilege or other purely procedural issues.
- 3 A new section 10.1(e.1) is added following section 10.1(e):
 - 10.1(e.1) When a vote is taken on a Substantive Motion by the raising of hands, the Chair will ask each Councillor present to verbally state his or her vote as being "for" or "against" the motion before declaring the result of the vote.
- 4 Section 10.1(b)(iii) is amended by adding "by stating "for" or "against" the motion," immediately following "Vote verbally".
- 5 Section 10.1(h) is added following section 10.1(g):
 - 10.1(h) A Councillor who disagrees with the announcement made of the result of a vote may immediately object to the declaration and the vote shall be retaken.
- 6 Section 10.2(c) is repealed.
