Optional Amendments for Bylaw 7-2017

Option 1: Rather than having the Chair verbally announce each individual Councillor's vote, have the Councillors, themselves, verbally state their vote.

Possible Amendment:

Section 4 of Bylaw 7-2017 is amended by deleting 10.1(e.1) and replacing it with:

- 10.1(e.1) "When a vote is taken on a Substantive Motion by the raising of hands, the Chair will:
 - (i) call for those in favour of the motion, and require each councillor voting in favour to verbally confirm their vote;
 - (ii) call for those opposed to the motion, and require each councillor voting in opposition to verbally confirm their vote; and
 - (iii) then declare the result of the vote.

Option 2: If a vote is unanimous, the Chair may declare that the vote is carried unanimously rather than calling out each individual vote.

Possible Amendment:

Section 4 of Bylaw 7-2017 is amended by adding a new section 10.1(e.2) as follows:

- 10.1(e.2) "If the vote is unanimous, the Chair may, in the discretion of the Chair, either:
 - (i) verbally state the names of each Councillor voting and declare the result, or
 - (ii) declare that the vote is carried or defeated unanimously."

And by renumbering subsection references accordingly.
