

BYLAW 11-2017

A BYLAW OF STRATHCONA COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING AND DISPOSING OF A PORTION OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c. M-26 provides that a municipality may by bylaw close a road; and

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described will no longer be required for public travel; and

WHEREAS application has been made to the Council to have the road closed to create a fee simple title interest in the name of Strathcona County to allow for consolidation into the adjacent parcel.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of Strathcona County duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Strathcona County does hereby close the following described highway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulation:

ALL OF ROAD PLAN 1516 B.M. LYING WITHIN THE N.E. ¼ SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 53, RANGE 22, WEST OF THE 4TH MERIDIAN.

2. This Bylaw comes into effect after third reading and upon being signed.
