

## Road Closure Bylaw 10-2017 (Ward 5)

**Applicant:** Canadian National Railway

Owner: Strathcona County

Legal Description: Road Plan 0122545, NE and SE 18-55-21-W4

**Location:** Range Road 215 and Highway 15

### **Report Purpose**

To hold a public hearing and thereafter give three readings to a bylaw that proposes the closure of Road Plan 0122545 to facilitate the implementation of the Access Management Plan and closure of a Canadian National (CN) level railway crossing.

#### Recommendations

- 1. THAT Bylaw 10-2017, a bylaw that closes Road Plan 0122545 within the NE and SE 18-55-21-W4, be given first reading.
- 2. THAT Bylaw 10-2017 be given second reading.
- 3. THAT Bylaw 10-2017 be considered for third reading.
- 4. THAT Bylaw 10-2017 be given third reading.

### **Strategic Plan Priority Areas**

**Economy:** The proposed road closure will not cause any financial burden to Strathcona County. **Governance:** The Public Hearing supports the strategic goal to increase public involvement on issues affecting the County's future and provides Council with the opportunity to receive public input prior to making a decision on the proposed bylaw.
