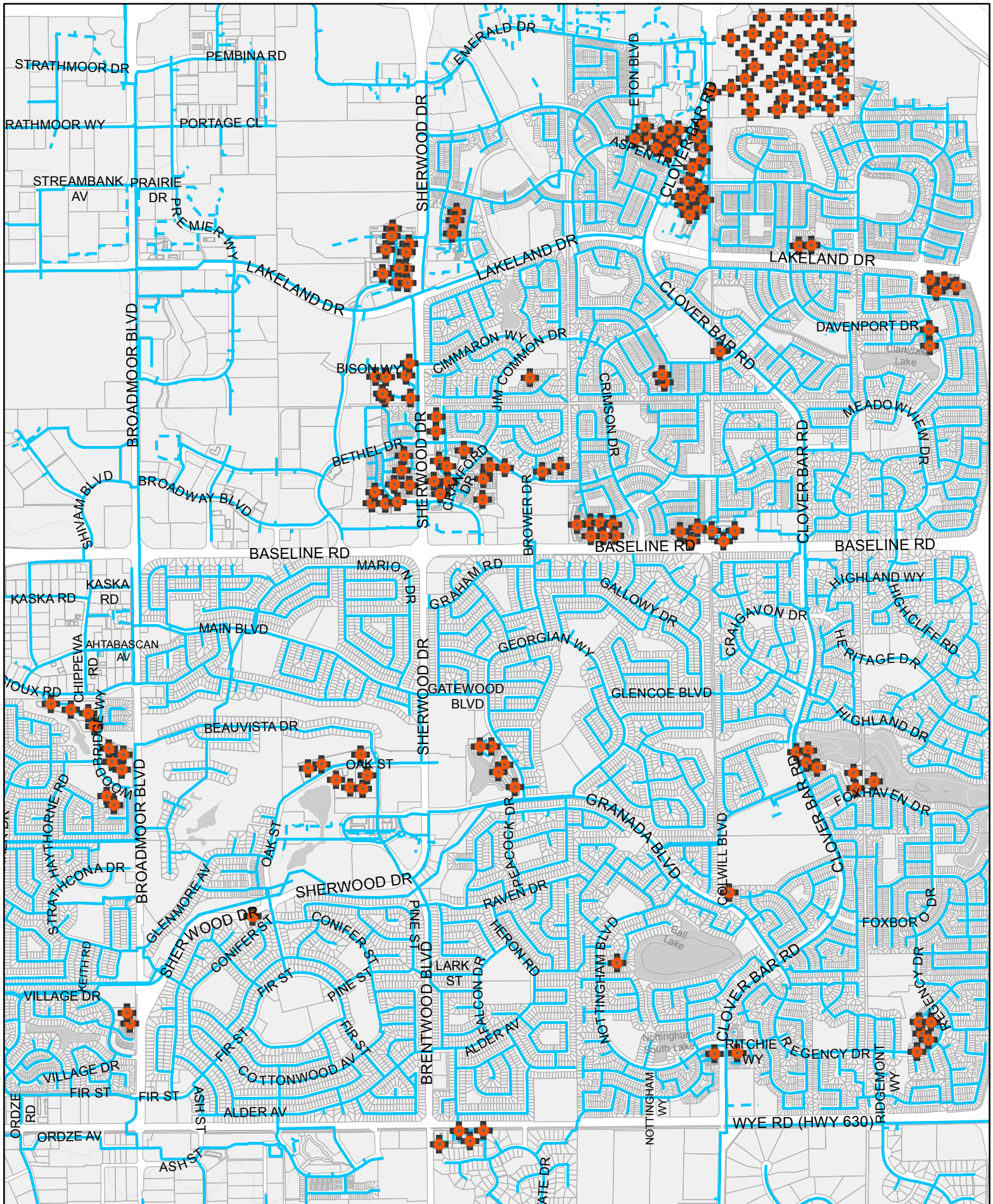
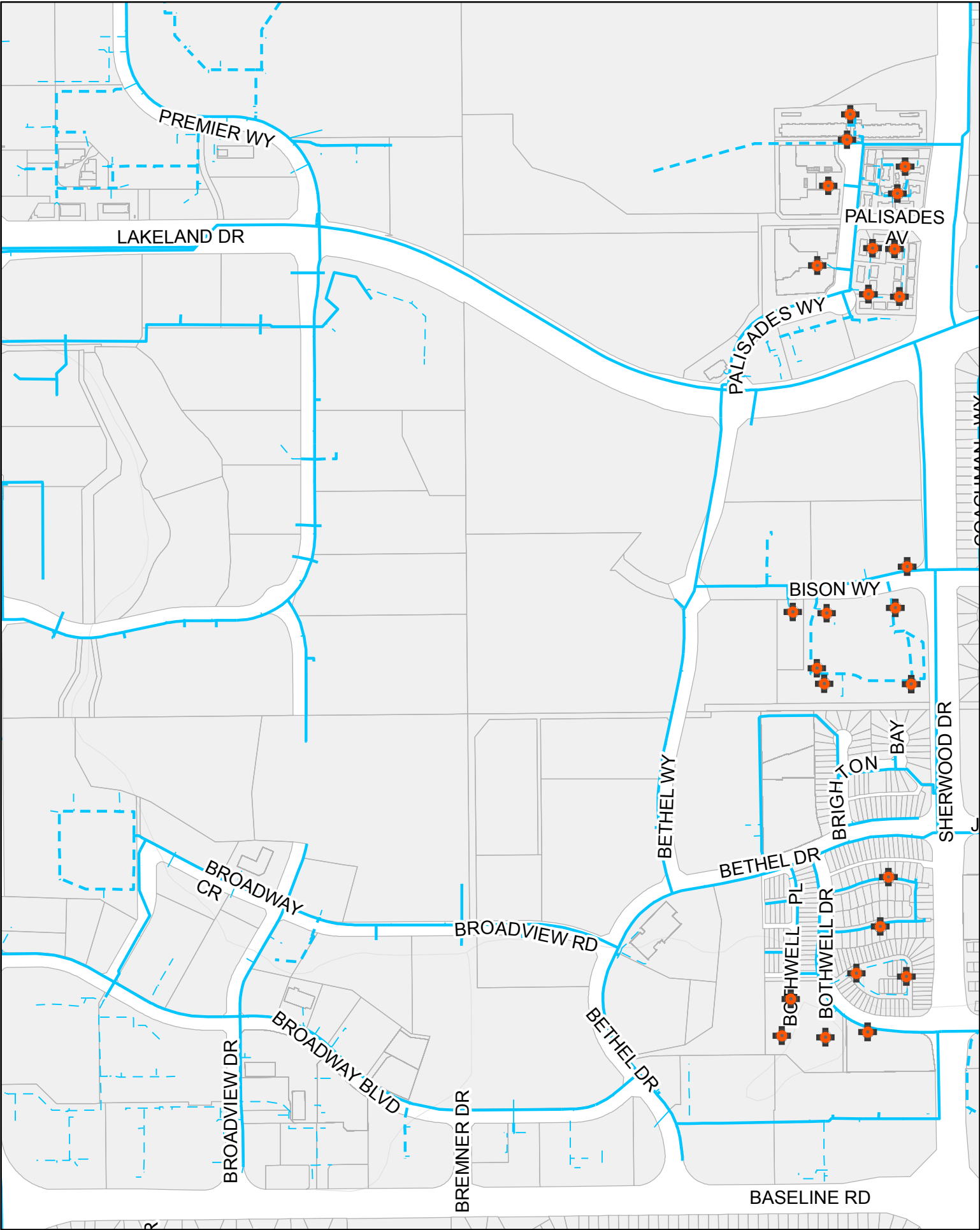


Private hydrants on multi-tenant residential: 171
