One of the main reasons cited was that they claimed that they already had satisfactory internet service through alternative sources . The letter that was recently sent out to those same 155 households was to follow up; we let them know that due to the opposition to the proposed tower site, the Internet Service Provider (MCSNet) is seeking an alternative tower site in order to service that area. We also asked them to let us know if they are not receiving satisfactory internet service. Since the second letter went out, we have heard from five area property owners (outside of the Brecken Woods subdivision) offering to host a tower, as well as from many area residents confirming that they do not have satisfactory internet access. C-3. In this act and its regulations the province has set out how cemeteries must be kept, how burials may occur, and where burials may occur. The Cemeteries Act applies to anyone who is an owner of a cemetery. Currently, Strathcona County does not own any cemeteries. As such, it does not have any obligations under the Cemeteries Act regarding the maintenance of cemeteries. If the County decided to take on the role as a cemetery owner, the obligations under the Cemeteries Act would only apply to cemeteries owned by the County (note that new cemeteries can only be owned by religious auxiliaries, a religious denomination, or a municipality). If a cemetery is not being maintained or operated properly (in accordance with the act and regulations) the Provincial Minister that is responsible can appoint an administrator to operate the cemetery.
