

Boards and Committees Honorary Bylaw

November 7, 2017

History

- December 8, 1998: Council passed resolution 698/98 prescribing remuneration to be paid to public members of boards and committees
- Since then practice adopted, but not captured in a policy or bylaw
- Currently no consistent practice for remuneration to public members of Council boards and committees

Recommendation

- Council pass Bylaw 34-2017, the Boards and Committees Honorarium Bylaw, which prescribes honoraria payable to citizen members of Council Committees, effective January 1, 2018
- Prescribing honoraria will help ensure that residents who want to serve on Council Committees are not prohibited from doing so by incidental costs related to such service
- Current rates and rates paid by other municipalities are included at Enclosure 2 to Report
