Report on the Activities of the Bylaw Enforcement Order Review Committee - 2017

Report Purpose

The purpose of this report to the Priorities Committee is to fulfill the requirement set out in Strathcona County Bylaw 46-2015 that a committee established pursuant to that bylaw report on its activities to the Priorities Committee at least once annually or as requested by the Priorities Committee.

Summary

The Bylaw Enforcement Order Review Committee receives, hears and decides requests for reviews filed with it for Orders issued pursuant to certain Strathcona County Bylaws and certain sections of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c M-26.

From January 1, 2017 to November 21, 2017, the Bylaw Enforcement Order Review Committee did not receive any request for review. The Bylaw Enforcement Order Review Committee met on January 5, 2017 to approve its most recent minutes and to elect a chair and vice-chair. The Bylaw Enforcement Order Review Committee has not held any other meetings.
