Report on the Activities of the General Appeals and Review Committee - 2017

Report Purpose

The purpose of this report to the Priorities Committee is to fulfill the requirement set out in Strathcona County Bylaw 46-2015 that a committee established pursuant to that Bylaw report on its activities to the Priorities Committee at least once annually or as requested by the Priorities Committee.

Summary
