

**Motion following Notice of Motion****Enforcement Services Bike Squad**

THAT Administration prepare a report for Council's consideration by the third quarter of 2018, on the implementation of a "Peace Officer Bike Squad" for the purpose of monitoring trail systems within Strathcona County; and that the report address the feasibility of funding such a bike squad from revenues generated from the speed on green program.

**Background**

Councillor Dave Anderson served a Notice of Motion at the December 12, 2017 Council meeting, to be presented at the January 23, 2018 Council meeting.

With the recent passing of the Dog Bylaw and the expected legalization of marijuana it is imperative to have Enforcement Services Peace Officers monitoring the trails and parks throughout the county. Several issues such as tagging, Guerilla Gardening, and the inappropriate use of lands can be monitored by increasing and changing how we do bylaw enforcement.

These services should be done by no less than two peace officers at all times to alleviate any safety issues.
