BYLAW 68-2017

A BYLAW OF STRATHCONA COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW NO. 6-2015, AS AMENDED, BEING THE LAND USE BYLAW.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend the Land Use Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Strathcona County, duly assembled, pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, *R.S.A. 2000* c.*M-26* and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

That Bylaw 6-2015, as amended, be amended as follows:

- 1. That Part 1, Section 1.17.4, be amended by:
 - a) adding after the end of the last sentence for the definition of agriculture, general "This does not include a cannabis production facility."
 - b) deleting the last sentence for the definition of agriculture, intensive horticulture and replacing it with "This does not include minor or intensive livestock agriculture, an agricultural product stand, a greenhouse or a cannabis production facility."
 - c) adding after the end of the last sentence for the definition of agriculture, product processing "This does not include a cannabis production facility."
 - d) adding the following definition after campsite and before canopy:

"CANNABIS PRODUCTION FACILITY means a facility, comprised of one or more buildings or structures, used for the purpose of growing, producing, cultivating, testing, processing, researching, destroying, storing, packaging or shipping of cannabis by a federal government licensed commercial producer in accordance with federal legislation. This does not include the growing or processing of plants that are considered by federal legislation to be industrial hemp."

e) adding after the end of the last sentence for the definition of greenhouse "This does not include a cannabis production facility."

 That Part 7, Section 7.17.2. be amended by: adding "cannabis production facility" to the list of Discretionary Uses.

This Bylaw comes into effect after third reading and upon being signed.
