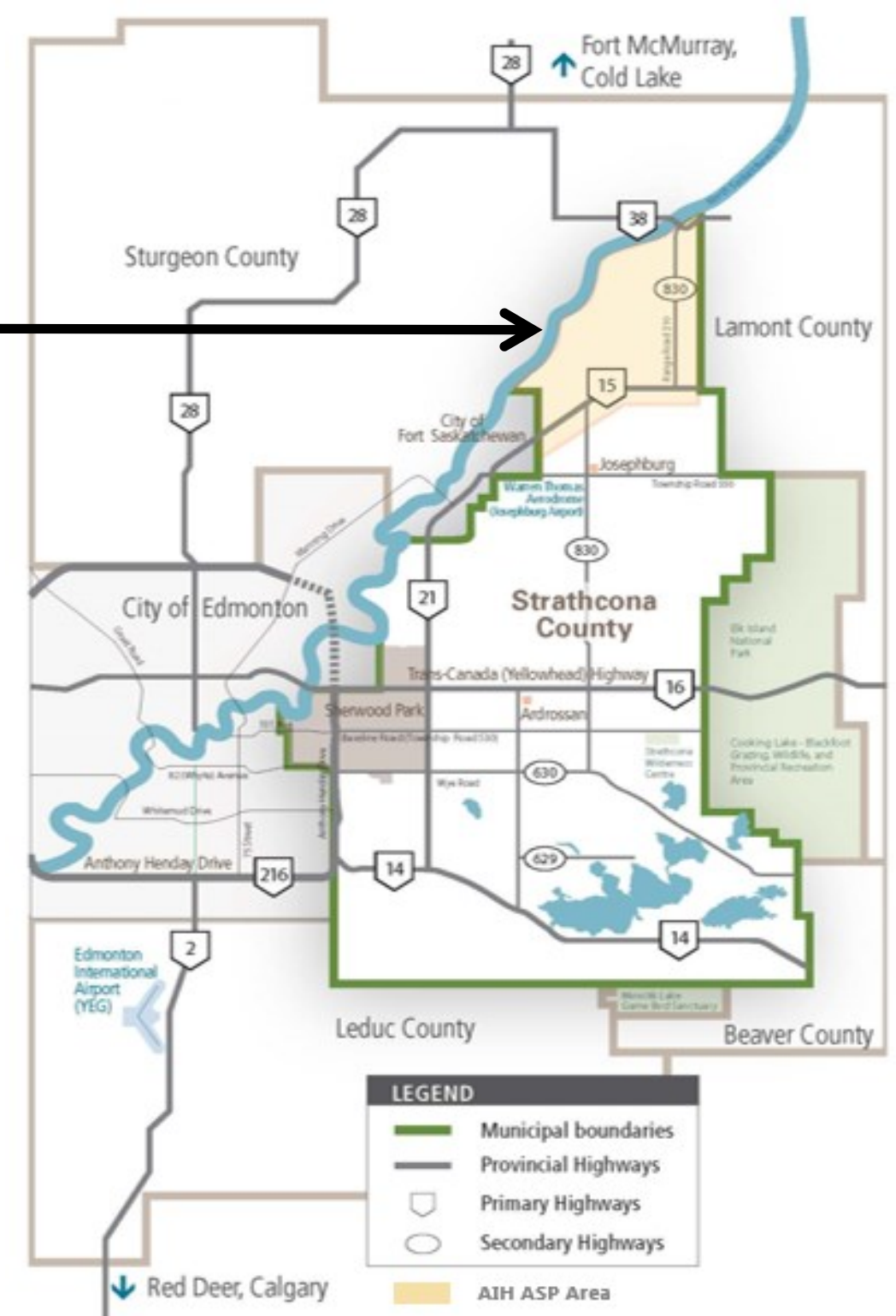

County

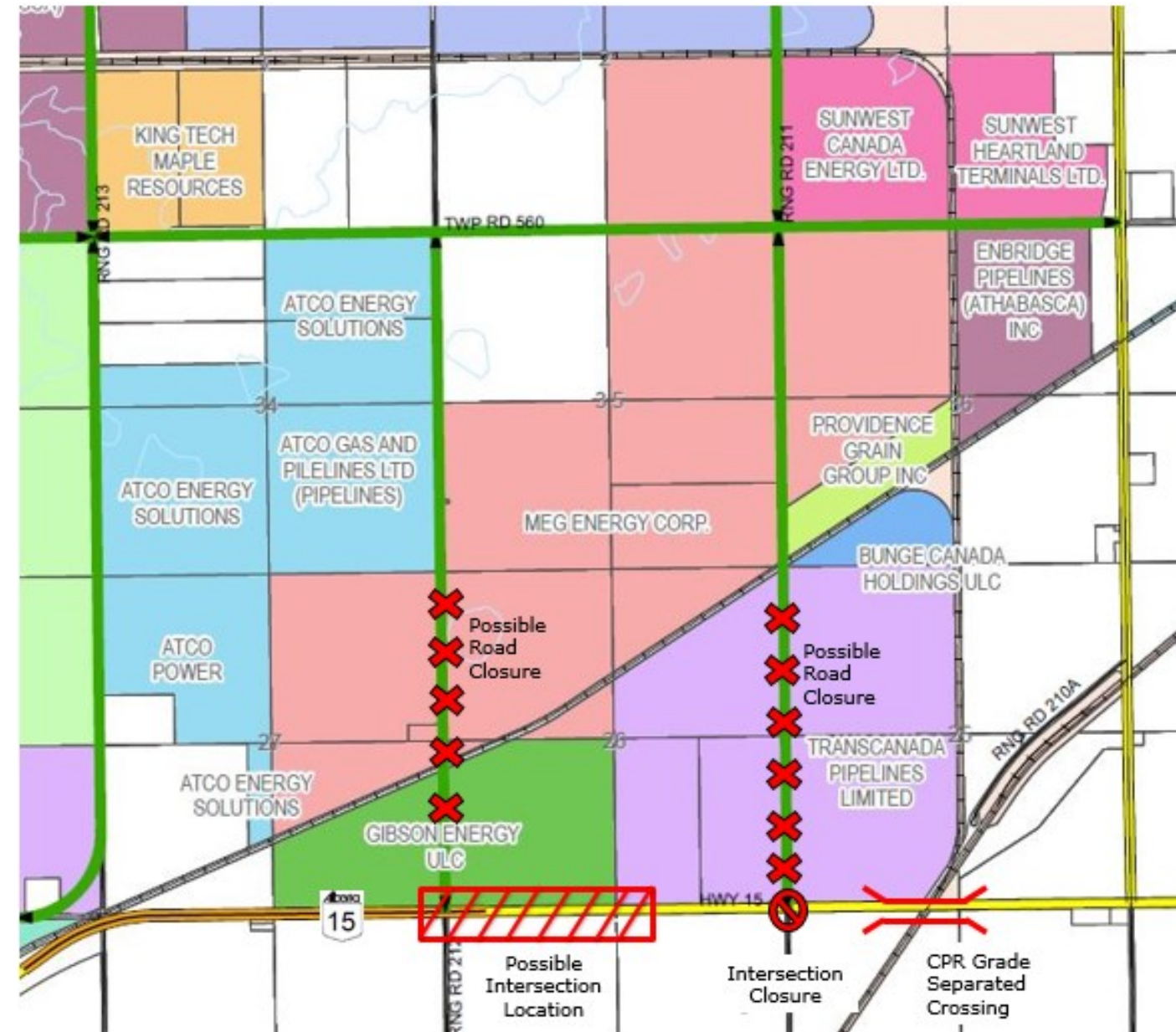


Project Scope

- Update the existing 2007 AIH Transportation Study
- Develop conceptual major internal road network
- Incorporate Transportation Study Update into Area Structure Plan (ASP)

Project Challenges/Constraints

- Recommendations from Highway 15 Functional Planning Study
- Safe and easy access to/from all sites
- Respect rights of landowners to secure site operations from through traffic
- Changing land uses
- Minimize additional railway crossings

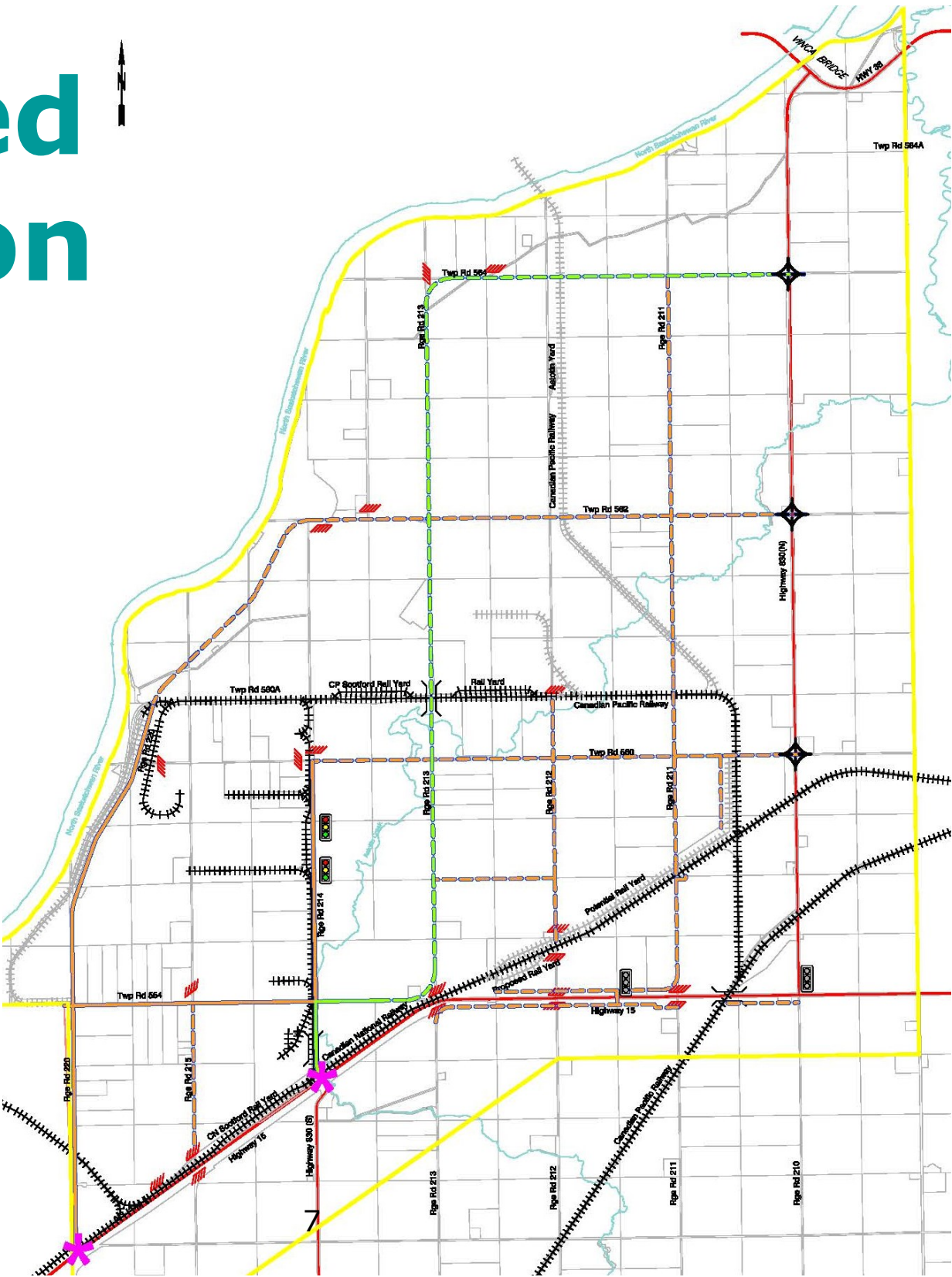
- Stakeholder Workshop No. 1 - May 2015

Guiding Principles

- Provide legal access
- Provide emergency access
- One intersection on Highway 15 between Rge Rd 212 and Rge Rd 211A
- Grade separation of the CP Rail tracks crossing Highway 15
- Closure of the Highway 15 and Range Road 211 intersection
- Respect rights of landowners to secure site operations from through traffic
- Minimize circuitous routes
