April 11, 2017 - Priorities Committee referred to Council for debate and decision the April 11, 2017 Governance Advisory Committee report, Further Review of Boards and Committees.

Summary

History

In April 2017, Council directed Administration to work with each Council Committee to develop a list of activities that each Council Committee could perform in 2018 and 2019. The lists were to include how each activity would support and facilitate the achievement of the Strategic Plan, vision and priorities. In November 2017, Priorities Committee was provided with the draft lists of activities by way of a Report for Information.

Draft Activity Lists

This report is brought before Priorities Committee so that the draft lists of activities can be discussed.

The Council Committee draft lists of activities identify the strategic plan goals to which the committee's activities align. Aligning Council Committee work to strategic goals will ensure that the County is continuing its efforts in priority based budgeting and business planning, while demonstrating efforts in advancing Council's Strategic Plan, and achieving the ultimate vision of becoming Canada's most livable community. The draft lists of activities are attached to this report as Enclosure 2.

Next Steps

If the draft activity lists are acceptable to the Priorities Committee, then Administration will proceed by presenting Council with the draft Mandate Letters for the Council Committees based on the lists. However, Priorities Committee may also provide Administration with suggested revisions to the lists.

Provided the Mandate Letters are approved by Council, Council Committees will then have more direction for work to be done in 2018 and 2019 since the Mandate Letters will inform the 2018 and 2019 work plans for each Council Committee.
