Introduction

Crimson Drive

- Collector road runs between Baseline Road and Clover Bar Road
- Traffic calmed with curb extensions, and roundabouts
- Residential units fronting the roadway
- Posted speed limit is 50 km/h
- Lakeland Ridge Junior high located near Cranberry Way
- School Zone
 - Cranberry Way to Clover Bar Rd
- 11 intersections and two roundabouts
- Approximate length; 1.7 km



- Traffic Control
- Travel Time
- Traffic Volume
- Vehicle Speed
- Collision History



- Traffic Control
 - Intersections
 - One Way Stop or Yield Controlled
 - Roundabouts
 - Yield Controlled
- Travel Time during off-peak conditions
 - NB Crimson Drive; 2 min, 23 sec
 - EB Baseline Road/NB Clover Bar Road; 3 min, 21 sec
 - 58 sec difference
 - SB Crimson Drive; 2 min, 29 sec
 - SB Clover Bar Road/WB Baseline Road; 2 min, 51 sec
 - 22 sec difference



- Traffic Volume
 - 2,500 veh/day to 3,100 veh/day
 - Traffic volume is balanced in both directions
 - Peak hour volume
 - 5-6pm, 160 vehicles; NB direction
 - 7-8am, 130 vehicles, SB direction
- Traffic Speed (in front of Cascade Park)
 - Avg. Speed; 48.8 km/h NB
 - 85th Percentile Speed; 56.5 km/h SB



- Collision History (2012-2016)
- 27 collisions
 - 1 major, 1 minor and 25 PDO
 - 10 collisions @ Crimson Drive/Chatwin Road roundabout
 - 22 collision occurred on slippery road surface conditions
 - 7 single vehicle collisions
 - Major cause lost control
 - No history of pedestrian/bicycle related collisions



Comparison Roads

Location	Volume Before	85 th Speed Before
Glencoe Blvd	~2100 vpd	60.4 – 60.9 km/h
Georgian Way South of Gatewood	~3400 vpd	56.8 – 74.1 km/
Glenbrook Blvd	~5100 vpd	57.7 – 64 km/h
Graham Rd	~2500 vpd	57.3 – 62.9 km/h
Jim Common Drive South	~5300 vpd	64.3 – 67.8 km/h



On-going Measures

- Ensure snow and ice is cleared according to policy in order to avoid the road condition crashes.
- Continue to monitor and research municipalities reducing neighbourhood road speed limits to 40km/h as part of the Neighbourhood Traffic Safety Action Plan.



Potential Additional Measure

 Consider installing permanent driver feedback signs (speed display boards) at two straightaway midblock locations near Cascade Park; one in each direction.
