Council History

February 2, 3 and 26, 2018 - Council conducted strategic planning sessions.
June 21, 2016 - Council approved revisions to the strategic plan.
May 6, 2014 - Council approved updates within the strategic plan.
February 25, 2014 - Council approved the revised community wide priority areas and prioritized strategic goals within the strategic plan.
April 23, 2013 - Council approved the strategic plan Strathcona County 2030.

Strategic Plan Priority Areas

Economy: Creating economic opportunity and diversification.

Governance: Public engagement and building partnerships within the community, the region, and with other levels of government.

Social: Support social inclusion and community connectedness while promoting livable, inclusive neighbourhoods and a healthy, active community.

Culture: Support a healthy, active community where people feel connected and have a strong sense of community.

Environment: Further environmental sustainability.

Council's strategic plan is Strathcona County's principal guiding document for governance, community development, infrastructure and program and service delivery. The plan identifies - for the community and others - the County's long-term planning.
