Summary

The current policy is being revised to align with the Strathcona County's Social Framework outcomes of: Affordability, Access to Programs and Services, Safety and Connectedness and Inclusion. User charges for social services have a range that is set by Council through the fees and charges bylaw as part of the budget process. This policy sets out criteria for the department to follow when assessing what fee is appropriate for each client. Fees for services are assessed to ensure user charges are not a barrier to accessing prevention and early intervention social services provided by Family and Community Services.
