Dear Councillor Lawrence,

On behalf of the Antler Lake Stewardship Committee (the ALSC), I wish to apply for Council Priority Funds in the amount of \$2,096.45. Last year, the ALSC piloted a weed removal project for the seniors of Antler Lake, hiring people with disabilities from the Robin Hood Association. The project was a success and we are now applying for funding to continue the project this year.

Antler Lake has many noxious weed species, including Common Tansy and Canada Thistle. The many seniors in the area lack the physical ability to manage these weeds on their own. Our program last year focused only on removing Common Tansy but this year we'd like to purchase strong gloves for those we hire from the Robin Hood Association, so we can expand our services to pull any noxious weeds on the seniors' properties.

This program benefits the seniors of Antler Lake and provides welcome employment to people with disabilities. Both parties would very much like our program to continue this year, as would the ALSC.
