Policy Statement

Recreation, Parks and Culture shall have guidelines, to develop, host, and promote special events for the general golfing public at the Broadmoor Golf Course.

Definitions

"Director" means the Director of Strathcona County Recreation, Parks and Culture.

Guidelines

- 1. Applicable special events may include reciprocal club play, learn-to golf, junior, city, zone, provincial and national events. Fees may be charged at the discretion of the Director and in an amount applicable to the standard of the event.
- 2. Events shall be affiliated with the Royal Canadian Golf Association (RCGA) or the Canadian Professional Golf Association (CPGA) and shall be offered on a fair and equitable rotation with other courses in the region.
- 3. Recreation, Parks and Culture will promote the Broadmoor Golf Course and ensure that it has a positive public image and that it receives appropriate exposure.
- 4. The Broadmoor Golf Course shall endeavor to promote golf opportunities for basic or beginner golfers by offering introductory golf classes, rules clinics and junior programs.
