Enclosed please find our application for funding to support our annual Carnival day which will be held in February 2019. Canadian Parents for French – Ardrossan Chapter have been organizing this cultural event for the French Immersion and non-French Immersion students at Ardrossan Elementary School for the past 9 years.

This is an event the students really enjoy and is supported by a large volunteer group of parents, junior high school students and fire fighters. Various stations are set up inside and outside of the school and the students rotate through them for the day. Grade 9 French Immersion students (approximately 30) and parent volunteers man the stations and guide students to the stations. Ardrossan Elementary Parent Support Association provides the funding for the horse and sleigh rental. Our chapter fund raises to contribute to the food and supply costs. We would ask the County to fund the entertainment and a portion of the food and supplies. The event is promoted on the school website, notices home to parents and in its newsletter. Strathcona County will be acknowledged in the newsletters pre and post event and on the activity map for the day.
