Legislative and Legal Services has been working with all Strathcona County departments to conduct a thorough policy review. The goal of the review includes updating policies such as the Train Whistle Cessation Policy to meet required formatting and structure as required by the *Municipal Government Act*. As a result, the Train Whistle Cessation Policy has not changed in its purpose or intent and will continue to guide the process required for a municipality to request and implement whistle cessation for at-grade rail crossings within Strathcona County.
