

A VISION FORWARD: OPERATIONS

Scenario 1

 Continue to support the SCMA through an operating agreement, providing incremental funding of \$200,000, for a total estimated annual funding of \$361,650, plus inflation.

Scenario 2

 Take on the governance and operation of the SCMA. This would impact the budget and workload of eight County departments; a preliminary cost estimate is \$500,000.

Scenario 3

 Close the Strathcona County Museum and Archives. The cost would be \$161,650 in 2019 and reduced to \$0 in subsequent years.

Scenario 4

 Hybrid of Scenarios 1 and 2. Costs would be \$361,650 annually for 3 years and would increase in years 4 through 7.



RECOMMENDATION AND NEXT STEPS

- 1. That Strathcona County provide additional support for the operations of the SCMA.
- That Strathcona County Council support in principle Visioning Scenario 1 – a new museum and archives within Centre in the Park – as the best community museum option. This location will position the Strathcona County Museum and Archives to become a cultural heritage amenity of excellence within an existing Cultural Hub.

That Strathcona County:

- Assist the SCMA in upgrading their information technology infrastructure and software programs to ensure compatibility with Strathcona County's information technology systems.
- 2. Immediate funding was provided in 2018 to offset critical issues.
