Report

Planning

Over the summer, conceptual site layouts were developed. Throughout the months of September and October, Transportation and Agriculture Services will be meeting with the user groups and requesting their feedback on the potential layouts.

Planning and Development Services and Transportation and Agriculture Services are currently developing a Master Plan for the site which is required for the permitting process.

Construction

Facility Services is finalizing the contract with an architectural firm who will complete the site design once the conceptual drawings have been vetted through the user groups.

The development of a master timeline is in progress for the project. This timeline will help provide awareness on the milestones for the project.
