SCOOP is an exciting new survey platform Strathcona County is launching to increase our profile with residents, create a sense of community among panel members and provide information with which Council and Administration can make informed, or evidence-based decisions.

Strathcona County employs public engagement to inform the community and its decisions. Surveys are one means by which we gather the opinions of residents on a variety of topics. Use of an online research panel, comprised of a group of self-selected community members, will enhance these efforts, improving both the quality and frequency of resident input impacting County decisions.
