Strathcona County Online Opinion Panel

- An opt-in, online community of engaged citizens
- Being launched today to:
 - → enhance public engagement
 - → facilitate more frequent and targeted data collection
 - → support evidence-based decisions



How does SCOOP work?

- Panelists fill out a demographic profile
- Through online surveys, polls and discussions, Strathcona
 County residents, business owners and people who work in the
 County will be asked to share their thoughts on topics such as:
 - → Strathcona County initiatives
 - → neighbourhood development
 - → social programs
 - → the environment



Advantages

- Profile data enables Strathcona County to direct surveys to the most relevant panelists (e.g., parents of preschoolers or transit users), resulting in higher response rates and more relevant data
- Facilitates regular input through an interested and engaged community of citizens
- Provides a mechanism for sharing survey results and follow-up actions more quickly with members



Next steps

- Working to grow SCOOP community—aim to have it representative of Strathcona County's population
- In the interim, will be using SCOOP alongside more traditional methods to gather data
