### **Report Purpose**

To provide Priorities Committee with an update on the Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility.

## Report

<u>Planning</u>

In October, Transportation and Agriculture Services and Crown Strategic Consulting conducted user group workshops to receive feedback on site layout and connectivity of the major design elements. This feedback will be used in the development of the concept design.

#### <u>Construction</u>

The proposed master timeline for the project is as follows:

Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility Project Schedule

- 1. Functional Programming August to October 2018
- Concept Design October to January 2019
   This stage determines the space schematics and flow diagrams for the facility and site
   in the functional program. It also begins to establish utility servicing requirements for
   the facility and site. Typically 2 or 3 conceptual options are developed.
- Schematic Design January to April 2019
   This stage begins to determine the architectural, landscape, structural, and mechanical requirements and design for the facility and site for the selected conceptual option to proceed with.
- 4. Design Development April to July 2019 This stage refines and describes the size and character of the facility and site, including: architectural requirements and design, mechanical systems, electrical systems, materials, and other required elements in more detail as identified in the functional program, stakeholder input, and code requirements.
- 5. Contract Documents February to October 2019
- 6. Permitting Approvals March to December 2019
- 7. Construction June 2019 to July 2021
  - Site Servicing- June 2019
  - Outdoor Amenities- May 2020
  - Indoor Facility- May 2020

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# *Finance*

The approved stage of the project includes: functional planning study, design, land, utilities, outdoor amenities and servicing. This stage of the project is proceeding as planned and on budget. \$6.6M of the total approved budget of \$23.8M has been spent to date.

## **Operating**

Planning and Development Services and Transportation and Agriculture Services are continuing development of a Master Plan which is required for the permitting process.

## Communication

45 user groups were contacted to participate in the workshops related to site layout and connectivity.

April 19, 2016	Priorities Committee was updated on the Development of a Functional Plan for the Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility.
May 12, 2015	THAT Council approve proceeding with partnership solicitation for the construction and operation of a Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility.
	THAT Council approve funding in the amount of \$75,000 from the Municipal Project Reserve (1.3773) to support the partnership solicitation process for the Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility.



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April 21, 2015	THAT the Priorities Committee refer the Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility Solicitation Process to the May 12, 2015 Council meeting for formal direction.
January 20, 2015	THAT Council direct Administration to bring back to the April 21, 2015 Priorities Committee Meeting a draft process to solicit partnership interest in building and operating a Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility.
