#### Report

At the July 17, 2018 Council meeting, Council had been debating a motion to establish a council committee for the purpose of advancing the Strathcona County Heritage Village. Council made a decision to refer that motion to Administration with instructions to prepare a report on an interim site plan by the end of 2018. Since that time, Administration has provided several updates to the Priorities Committee relating to the Multi-Purpose Agricultural Facility. The concept drawings that have been developed incorporate several heritage components throughout the site. Administration has held three stakeholder feedback sessions which included representation from the Strathcona County Heritage Village to help further refine the site concepts. Administration will continue to meet with stakeholders throughout the planning process. The Agricultural Service Board, which is a Council Committee, is currently involved and advising on the project.
