### Winter Maintenance Update - Unforeseen Climatic Conditions Clause

## **Report Purpose**

To provide the Priorities Committee with an update on the enactment of the unforeseen climatic conditions clause from the Winter Maintenance Policy.

## **Our Prioritized Strategic Goals**

Continuously improving the way we work, as one organization, in an agile and sustainable manner

### Report

Administration regularly reviews its Winter Maintenance Policy with Council to ensure it effectively addresses snow clearing needs as the community grows and changes.

Due to the amount of snow that fell in December 2018, Transportation and Agriculture Services enacted the "unforeseen climatic conditions" clause in our winter maintenance policy, which significantly shortens the timeframe for snow clearing. Snow fall began on December 2, and by early December 3 we had received 24 centimetres of snow. As this is only the second time this clause has been enacted, we will review the event, operational challenges, opportunities for improvement, and feedback from the public.
