How does SCOOP work?

• Panellists:

- can be residents, work or own businesses in the County
- fill out a demographic profile, before responding to surveys and polls
- To date, panellists have shared their thoughts online regarding topics such as:
 - County communication about winter maintenance
 - census participation
 - Transit Master Plan recommendations
 - annual public satisfaction survey



SCOOP by the numbers

As of January 14, 2019 we have:

```
910 panellists
20 completed surveys
3,179 survey responses
5,568 poll responses
654 mixed topic responses (two surveys)
```

- Several surveys had a 50 per cent response rate!
- First targeted demographic survey completed for Range Roads 231/232:
 - 87 surveys sent
 - 30 responded (34 per cent response rate)



Panellists by the numbers

Advantages of SCOOP

- Allows us to direct questions to panellists affected by a particular issue
- Supports iterative surveys (drill down based on previous answers)
- Facilitates reminding panellists who haven't completed a certain survey before the closing date
- Provides panellists with timely results of surveys and any resulting County actions



Panellists' thoughts about SCOOP

- About nine out of 10 panellists surveyed joined in September (65 per cent) and October (24 per cent).
- 76 per cent of panellists surveyed felt they are more informed about the County as a result of completing SCOOP surveys.
- 60 per cent of panellists surveyed said they felt more involved with what is going on in the County as a result of completing SCOOP surveys.

SCOOP gives residents a voice

I like being involved / I feel like I have a voice /
It's great to provide feedback to help shape our direction /

How is SCOOP working for you so far?

SCOOP helps residents with keeping informed

It's allowing our family to be aware of what is happening / SCOOP is improving my knowledge of County services / Made me aware of opportunities I've missed (19 mentions)

Greater need for sharing of the results

I like to know the survey results / More sharing of the results / I want to be aware of what is being done with my feedback (6 mentions)



Next steps

- Working to grow SCOOP community and to have it represent Strathcona County's population:
 - Efforts under way to recruit more men, rural residents, as well as people under the age of 34 and over the age of 75
- Rolling out more profile surveys to enable departments to connect with their target audiences
- Participating in the Sherwood Park and District Chamber of Commerce trade fair and sale in April for in-person recruitment
- Working on improved processes for reporting results of SCOOP surveys
