## Councillor Request Inquiry # 49-2018

In response to Mayor Frank's November 13, 2018 Council Information Request regarding resources for a Security Review, the Chief Commissioner's office, through information from Facility Services, Corporate Finance, and RCMP Enforcement Services, provides the following information.

Through discussions with the consultant, the current scope of the Council Chambers Security Review is being amended to include overall building security of Strathcona County facilities and staff. Additional funding to meet the need of the expanded work falls within discretionary approval by the Chief Commissioner. When complete, the report will be presented to Council.

Given their experience with incidents in Slave Lake, High River and Fort McMurray, advice is being sought from the Alberta Emergency Management Association (AEMA) with regard to supports and processes prior to initiating a facilitated action review of the initial response and the recovery phase associated with the November 6 incident.
