On behalf of the Sherwood Park Handball Club, I respectfully submit an application for financial assistance for the hosting of a special event, being held August 9, 10 and 11, 2019 entitled the Western Canadian Open 1 – Wall Outdoor Handball Championships.

The County currently has the finest set of 1 - Wall outdoor handball courts, in Western Canada, and possibly all of Canada: three world class courts at the Glen Allan Recreation Center adjacent to Wes Hosford School, and one court at the Kinsmen Leisure Centre. The Kinsmen Leisure Centre court was built when Sherwood park hosted the World 1 - Wall Handball championships in 2006. Since that time, the 1 - wall game has been gaining in popularity across North America, the United Kingdom, and Europe. Our Sherwood Park club is a leader in developing this sport in Western Canada.

As with any sport, the pinnacle of competition happens through tournaments, championships, and special events. Our August tournament will represent the championship declaration for this sporting event. Our club has the volunteer energy and experience to host an event recognized and sanctioned by the Alberta Handball Association and Canadian Handball Association. We are seeking Council's support to make this an event remembered by the competitors, their families, the officials, event volunteers, event organizers, the spectators, and public. We will make our County proud of our ability to host, organize, recognize, and help to continue the development of the sport for years to come.

## Quick Facts:

- The Sherwood Park Handball Club has existed for close to 45 years. We are a registered, not for profit club under the Alberta Societies act. We play on 4-wall courts indoors and 1-wall courts both indoors and outdoors.
- Our club has male and female players 7 to 86 years of age, at present.
- The club conducts clinics throughout the Elk Island School system exposing students, teachers, and coaches to the game, plus public awareness events.
- One-wall handball is one of the least expensive to participate in. "All you need is a ball and a wall".
- The Sherwood Park Handball Club also hosts an indoor 4-wall handball tournament in November each year known as the ""White Owl Open Handball Tournament". Our club has also hosted local, provincial, Western Canadian, national, and world championships.
- We expect players and officials from Edmonton, Calgary, Grand Prairie, Kelowna, Vancouver, Victoria, Seattle, Regina, and Winnipeg.
- We forecast 60 players, plus volunteers, plus officials, media personnel, and many public spectators during the event.
- Play will start Friday, August 9 and finish on Sunday afternoon August 11.
- There will be an entry fee for players to apply towards our expenses. Players also pay their own travel and accommodation expenses

In closing, we will use County vendors for event resources and expenses. We will also recognize Strathcona County on any recognition items and awards, and would offer elected officials a fun exposure to game clinics. Enclosed is our anticipated budget.
