Recommendation

- 2. THAT Bylaw 13-2019 be given second reading.
- 3. THAT Bylaw 13-2019 be considered for third reading.
- 4. THAT Bylaw 13-2019 be given third reading.
- 5. THAT Councillor Tonita be appointed to the Intermunicipal Relations Committee for a term ending at the 2019 Organizational Meeting, and as long as the appointee continues to serve on Council throughout the term of appointment.
