Green Routine 2.0 - Waste Diversion Program Update

Report

The Green Routine program was launched in June 2008. After ten years the primary goal of delivering convenient, economical and effective waste diversion opportunities while increasing community awareness about waste minimization and diversion, remains. Utilities continues to implement and propose initiatives that utilize waste management industry best practices.

The enclosed presentation provides an update to the program after the recent changes to blue bag recycling. This update includes an overview of Green Routine 2.0 including the observations and data collected over the last six months that will help inform the path forward for the program.
