Sherwood Park United Church's vision is "Following Christ, we care and act"

Our vision elements are:

SPUC has been a community of faith in Strathcona County for over 50 years.

Sherwood Park United Church's 'United Harmony" handbell choir has a paid part time director and 20 volunteer bell ringers, the majority who are from the community. The bell choir rings during, at least, four church services a year and participate in two music services annually joining our choir and accompanists. These music services are advertised locally and we do have people from the community attend. They also provide outreach to the community by ringing at lodges, nursing homes, other churches and community functions.

We have had bell ringers attend workshops. In December 2019, 5 of our bell ringers and our director (at their own expense) will participate in the "Great Christmas Ring" in New York City. Bell ringers from all over Canada and United States will attend this event. The bells will be ringing in Carnegie Hall and Central Park.

We have been working towards a two 3 octave choir. Having a double bell choir (the only one we are aware of in Alberta) would really enhance our sound.

The chimes we have requested will enhance the deep bass sound that is often needed.

Also, we are requesting funding for a case for the small bells. At the present time they are stored in a cardboard box, not particularly a safe place for storage and travels.

We respectfully ask Council's consideration in supporting our request for funding through the Council Priority Funding.
