

Bylaw 29-2019 Chief Commissioner Recruitment Committee Bylaw

Report Purpose

To seek Council approval on three readings of Bylaw 29-2019, a bylaw that establishes the Chief Commissioner Recruitment Committee, and to have members of Council appointed to this Committee.

Recommendation

- 3. THAT Bylaw 29-2019 be considered for third reading.
- 4. THAT Bylaw 29-2019 be given third reading.
- 5. THAT Mayor Frank and Councillors Berghofer, Parks, and Tonita be appointed to the Chief Commissioner Recruitment Committee.

Administration has prepared a bylaw (enclosure 1) that establishes a Chief Commissioner Recruitment Committee. This committee will support Council in the conduct of the process to recruit the new Chief Commissioner. The Committee will have the powers, duties and functions delegated to it by Council through the bylaw. Provided that the bylaw receives three readings, committee members will need to be appointed.
