Report Purpose

Report

The Community Cemetery Assessment has been designed with three distinct phases. Phase 1 will explore a market & community demand analysis, stakeholder and community engagement and community cemetery forms and operational structures. This phase begins in June, 2019; the final report will be completed by December 31, 2019 and presented to Council in January, 2020. Should Council decide to proceed, 2 additional phases will follow.
