Report

Planning and Development Services is working with Stantec to develop a Municipal Land Framework. The purpose of the Municipal Land Framework is to develop a high-level document that sets a vision for short and long-term use of municipal land, develops a property asset management plan, and identifies future land needs. The framework will guide decision making for land requirements for current County capital plans, operations and services, as well as for future municipal, recreational, and economic growth for the next 25 years, taking into consideration financial, social, economic, and environmental impacts.

The framework will focus on principles of integrity, public interest, fiscal accountability, compliance with regulations, transparency of process, and outline the roles and responsibilities associated with property asset management ensuring that decisions about County land contributes to the County's vision to be the most livable community.
