Due to our Ardrossan Senior's building being too small to cook and serve this supper, we need to rent the Ardrossan Recreation Complex Centre hall.

We have approximately 30 volunteers who work this event, with about 100 total volunteer hours. We serve the residents of the county, including Sherwood Park. Advertisements are placed in the Sherwood Park News and the Booster papers, as well as posters. We also have a calendar which we email to members with emails and we also phone members.

The Sherwood Park Dairy Queen kindly donates one pail of strawberries and we purchase one. Other than this, we do not have any other donations.

This supper feeds over 200 people, including volunteers and we are pleased to offer this supper to the community. Of course, if anyone came in and couldn't afford the supper, we would graciously give them a free supper.
