Core Social Funding and Collaboration Funding Grants are allocated through an annual granting process. Applications for 2020 were received and processed according to the policy in November of 2019. Recommendations for grant allocations are developed following a review by the administrative Social Framework Community Grants Advisory Committee. Allocation of grant dollars are approved by Council. Total available funds for the 2020 Social Framework Community Grants is \$1,094,660.
