Youth Advisory Committee 2019 Annual Report

Report Purpose

To update the Priorities Committee on the 2019 activities and accomplishments of the Youth Advisory Committee, as required by Strathcona County Bylaw 31-2018.

Our Prioritized Strategic Goals

Goal 1 - Build strong communities to support the diverse needs of residents

Goal 7 - Provide opportunities for public engagement and communication

Report

The purpose of the Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) is to provide advice and recommendations to Council on issues and opportunities involving or affecting youth. The YAC's work is in alignment with Council's Strategic Plan, Strathcona County's Social Framework and key strategies and policies of the county. The YAC provides a youth lens on Strathcona County policies, programs and services and provides advice to Council and Administration on policies and programs to improve outcomes for youth in Strathcona County.

The following are mandate items for the YAC, and the activities undertaken in 2019:

- Recreation and Culture Strategy: reviewed the draft Recreation and Culture Strategy and contributed input to inform implementation planning for the strategy.
- Engagement of youth in democracy: planned and implemented a federal election youth forum on October 18, 2019 targeting youth and young adults.
- Youth Needs and Assets Assessment: participated as a focus group for this initiative and provided advice on the recommendations proposed for the final report. Key issues identified through these discussions included affordable housing, mental health issues and transit issues.
- Diversity and Inclusion: provided input on engagement for the draft policy and provided input on actions that will be important to implement this policy.
- Community Cemetery: while this was not a mandate item, the Community Living Advisory in its work on this item recommended the YAC be consulted. The YAC participated in a discussion to help inform the community cemetery report to Council and are supportive of a community cemetery.

Mandate items to be completed in 2020 include:

- Effective youth engagement
- Engage on matters such as post-secondary education, diversity and inclusion, and the Community Drug Strategy
- Connect with others successfully engaging with youth for shared learning

The 2019 YAC consisted of six public voting members and two Councillors who are non-voting members.
