To request a time extension on the preparation of a report to Council on cannabis production.

## **Council and Committee History**

February 26, 2019 THAT the Planning and Development Services report on the advisability

of an amendment to the Strathcona County Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 be brought back to Council by the revised date of the second quarter of

2020.

June 5, 2018 THAT Council direct administration to prepare a report on the

advisability of an amendment to the Strathcona County Land Use Bylaw 6- 2015 in AG-Agriculture: General district by the fourth quarter of

2018 that:

- A cannabis production facility with a total area greater than 1000 m2 shall meet the minimum separation distance of 500 meters between an existing dwelling and the cannabis production facility site.
- 2. The minimum separation distance between the existing dwelling and a cannabis production facility site shall be established by measuring the shortest distance between the external wall of the nearest dwelling and the boundary of the cannabis production facility site.

### **Rationale**

As there is still outstanding litigation relating to cannabis production facilities in Strathcona County, administration requests an extension on this item.
