Report

Since Motion 2018/395 was approved by Council in October of 2018, administration has prepared four reports for the Priorities Committee related to the status of activity in the Cambrian Crossing area. Also in that time, Policy SER-009-044, Offsite Development Levies for New Growth Areas was approved, as well as approvals for land acquisition for two parcels in the North of Yellowhead area.

The approval of Policy SER-009-044 led to the County meeting with developers on September 26, 2019, to further discuss offsite servicing options for underground utilities and roadway infrastructure, as well as financing and security options as identified in the new Policy. The County continues to work with developers on a Memorandum of Agreement of Intent to enter into a Tri-Party Agreement. This memorandum will outline the main provisions, roles, commitments, triggers, securities, etc. of a Tri-Party Agreement. Once agreed to, the memorandum would allow for the detailed design of water, wastewater, and Range Road 231 to the third access to commence (once Alberta Transportation (AT) has completed their functional planning design).

The goal is to have the Tri-Party Agreement ready for the parties to review in Q1 of 2020. Once agreed to, and if the associated budget items receive approval, the construction of servicing for the area could commence.

Administration met with AT on September 25, 2019, where the preferred long-term option for the Clover Bar Road/Highway 16 interchange was selected. This option allows for the connection of the service road west of Range Road 231 to be in place over the long term. AT is proceeding with completing functional design plans for the ultimate interchange. Further meetings with AT have occurred that will help AT develop roadway/interchange staging plans for this area.

October 23, 2018	Priorities Committee was provided an update on the status of the detail design for the Range Road 231 – CN Rail overpass.
September 18, 2018	Priorities Committee was provided with the Report for Information, North of Yellowhead Servicing, Development, and Financial Quarterly Report for information purposes only.

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July 17, 2018 Council approved commencement of a detailed design for construction of a rail overpass at Range Road 231 and the CN track crossing, with a design budget up to \$1.6 million and added to the 2018 Capital Budget, and that developers in the North of Yellowhead area be consulted to discuss plans for construction. Council approved an amendment to the 2014 and 2015 Capital June 19, 2018 Budgets to cancel the North of Yellowhead water, wastewater, roadway and land infrastructure projects that have not started in the total amount of \$53,065,641. December 12, 2017 That an amendment to 2013 Capital Budget for a change in funding only for the 2013 Strategic Land Purchase in the amount of \$5,100,000 from municipal taxes to development levy, to be financed by the existing debenture, be approved. THAT Priorities Committee recommend to Council: THAT November 21, 2017 Administration bring Quarterly Status reports on the North of Yellowhead Project to Priorities Committee throughout 2018 until the project is underway. March 25, 2014 Council adopted Bylaw 45-2013, a bylaw that amended the Municipal Development Plan to facilitate a change in land use policy areas for the NE 24-53-23-W4 and the area west of Old Man Creek within sections 24-53-23-W4 and 13-53-23-W4. March 25, 2014 Council adopted the: Revised North of Yellowhead Area Concept Plan Bylaw 46-2013 (and repealed previous Bylaw 36-2010); Revised Cambrian Crossing Area Structure Plan Bylaw 47-2013 (and repealed previous Bylaw 37-2010). December 10, 2013 Council approved the 2014 Consolidated Capital Budget for Municipal, Utility and Library Operations which included: \$1,740,662 - Highway 16 Ramp and Clover Bar Road Intersection design and construction (WIP 500358) Transportation Planning and Engineering (TPE); and

\$393,750 - Township Road 534 and Highway 21

Intersection design (WIP 500360) (TPE).

August 13, 2013

Council gave second and third readings to Bylaw 49-2013.

July 2, 2013

Council approved capital budget amendments to reallocate the North of Yellowhead Land component in the amount of \$4,000,000 from the 2012 North of Yellowhead Design and Land Project (WIP 500224) to the new 2013 Strategic Land Project (WIP 500350) that included additional municipal tax supported debenture financing of \$12,925,000.

July 2, 2013

Council amended the 2012 Capital Budget to decrease the cost of the North of Yellowhead Design and Land – Utilities project by \$500,000 for cost savings and release the funding commitment from the North of Yellowhead Trunk Line Levy (1.4777).

July 2, 2013

Council gave first reading to Bylaw 49-2013, a bylaw to approve the incurrence of indebtedness on behalf of Strathcona County by the issuance of debentures or loans for the purpose of a Strategic Land Purchase.

December 11, 2012

Council approved the 2013 Consolidated Capital Budget for Municipal, Utility and Library Operations which included:

December 13, 2011

January 25, 2011

Council adopted Bylaw 35-2010, a bylaw that amended the Municipal Development Plan Bylaw 1-2007 to support the Cambrian Crossing Area Structure Plan.

- North of Yellowhead Area Concept Plan Bylaw 36-2010 (and repealed previous Bylaw 51-2003); and
- Cambrian Crossing Area Structure Plan Bylaw 37-2010.



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November 10, 2009 Council authorized administration to proceed with a review and

update of the North of Yellowhead Area Concept Plan.
