

Winfield Heights – Rural Water Services Local Improvement Project

Report Purpose

To seek Council approval on three readings of Bylaw 36-2020 and Bylaw 37-2020, that authorize the design and construction of the Winfield Heights low-pressure trickle system through a local improvement tax levy financed by debenture borrowing.

Recommendation

THAT Bylaw 36-2020, a bylaw to authorize a local improvement tax levy to pay for the Winfield Heights low-pressure trickle system be given first reading.

THAT Bylaw 36-2020 be given second reading.

THAT Bylaw 36-2020 be considered for third reading.

THAT Bylaw 36-2020 be given third reading.

THAT Bylaw 37-2020, a bylaw to authorize the Council of Strathcona County to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in the amount of \$452,375 for the purpose of financing the design and construction of a low-pressure trickle system for the residents of Winfield Heights be given first reading.

THAT Bylaw 37-2020 be given second reading.

THAT Bylaw 37-2020 be considered for third reading.

THAT Bylaw 37-2020 be given third reading.

Report

On March 23, 2020, Legislative and Legal Services declared the sufficiency of a Local Improvement Petition to design and construct a low-pressure trickle system to service the homes in the country residential subdivision of Winfield Heights.

A local improvement plan was circulated to the affected landowners on April 28, 2020. If no sufficient petition objecting to the local improvement is filed within thirty (30) days from the sending of the notices, council must undertake the local improvement. No petition objecting to the local improvement has been received.

Legislative/Legal: Section 397 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c. M-26 (MGA) authorizes a local improvement tax levy. Sections 251 through 263 of the Municipal Government Act (MGA), R.S.A. 2000, c.M-26 govern municipal borrowing. Notice of the

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borrowing bylaw is not required pursuant to Section 263 of the MGA, as the amount to be borrowed will be covered by the local improvement tax levy.
