| Purpose | 1 The purpose of this bylaw is to amend Bylaw 17-2020 to provide an in-person option for certain presentations to Council and Priorities Committee, including Public Hearings. |
| Amendments | <p>2 Bylaw 17-2020 is amended as follows:</p> <p>(a) The word "will" is deleted and replaced with the word "may" in Section 2(a);</p> <p>(b) Section 2(b) is deleted and replaced with:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) Persons interested in making a submission as part of the Public Hearing may contact the Director's office to provide a written submission by email; and may either:</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">i. Register to make a presentation at the Public Hearing by electronic means; or</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">ii. Register to make a presentation at the Public Hearing in person.</p> <p>(c) Section 2(c) is deleted;</p> <p>(d) The words "or in person" are added following the words "electronic means" in Section 2(i); and</p> <p>(e) The word "must" is deleted and replaced with the word "may" in Sections 3 and 4.</p> |
