Report

Strathcona County continues to follow the public health direction of Alberta Health during the COVID-19 pandemic. Although the Province of Alberta has not mandated the use of masks, they are strongly recommending the use of masks as a mitigation measure. Through administrative authority masks can be made a requirement for municipal buildings and vehicles.

In keeping with this provincial approach Strathcona County Transit started distributing nonmedical masks to the public effective Monday, July 27, 2020 and are strongly encouraging residents to wear masks on public transit and in public spaces.

While the Province of Alberta would be in the best position to mandate the wearing of face coverings by the general public, under Council's direction, Strathcona County can enact bylaws with respect to the safety, health and welfare of people, and the protection of people and property, under the Municipal Government Act.

The health and safety of the community including staff remains a top priority in this rapidly changing and evolving situation. Strathcona County is encouraging community members to support and protect one another during this time as restrictions continue to be lifted and more facilities and services are opened to the public.
