

### **Disposal of Assets Policy Exception Request**

## **Report Purpose**

Fleet Services seeks an exception to the Disposal of Assets policy in order to sell for \$1 (one dollar) a 1955 Chev 1643 tanker, that is no longer in use by the County, to the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF).

#### Recommendation

THAT, despite the provisions of Policy SER-014-006, the sale of the 1955 Chev 1643 tanker to the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) for \$1 (one dollar), be approved.

### Report

The current Disposal of Assets policy indicates that a surplus vehicle may be disposed by auction, consignment or tender sale. Fleet Services has had this tanker since approximately 1960 and has not used it in many years. The International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) intends to use this tanker for community events. A direct sale would be preferable in this case for preservation of a unique vehicle as well as relationship building with the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF).
