At the November 18, 2019 meeting, Council approved Bylaw 37-2019 2020 Fees, Rates and Charges. The proposed bylaw will amend the bylaw number for Bylaw 37-2019 Planning and Development Red Tape Reduction by assigning the bylaw a new number 43-2019.
