

Councillor Appointments to Boards, Committees, and Commissions – 2019 Fall**Report Purpose**

To appoint Councillors to various boards, committees and commissions.

Recommendation

THAT the appointments of the Councillors to boards, committees, and commissions, as set out in enclosure 1 to the November 19, 2019, Legislative and Legal Services report, be approved for the terms set out therein, providing the appointees continue to serve as Councillors throughout the terms of appointment.

Report

Council appoints Councillors to boards, committees, and commissions in accordance with each body's bylaws or other constituting documents. As much as possible, the proposed appointments balance the personal interests of councillors, the entity's requirements, and councillor workloads.

The enclosure sets out the appointments to external boards, committees, and commissions, as well as to any council committees with vacancies for terms commencing November 19, 2019. The term expiry dates vary depending on whether 2-year terms are permitted for the particular board, committee, or commission.

Council and Committee History

October 16, 2018 Councillor appointments were made to various external boards, committees and commissions.

Other Impacts

Policy: GOV-001-019 requires Council to appoint at least one elected member to each board, committee, and commission of which the County is a member, and allows when possible for appointments of 2-year terms.

Legislative/Legal: Section 153 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c M-26, requires Councillors to participate in meetings of bodies to which they are appointed by Council.
