### Report

The purpose of the Seniors Advisory Committee (SAC) is to provide advice and recommendations to Council on issues and opportunities related to the physical, emotional, and social wellbeing of seniors in Strathcona County. The SAC's work is in alignment with Council's Strategic Plan, Strathcona County's Social Framework and key strategies and policies of the county. The SAC provides a seniors' lens on Strathcona County policies, programs and services and provides advice to Council and Administration on policies and programs to improve outcomes for seniors in Strathcona County.

The following are mandate items for the SAC undertaken thus far in 2020:

- Supporting active and engaged seniors: conducted four surveys to understand seniors' perspectives on community involvement, health and well-being, housing and transportation.
- Engage with seniors' groups: connected with 7 seniors' groups to share evolving priorities and opportunities for collaboration.
- Recommend areas of further engagement: bringing forward considerations as a midterm report, in addition to the March 2020 annual report.
