Indoor Fieldhouse Update

Report Purpose

To provide the Priorities Committee with an update on the indoor fieldhouse project.

Report

In October of 2018, the Sherwood Park District Soccer Association presented a report to the Priorities Committee proposing the need for an indoor, full-size, non-boarded turf field. Following this presentation, Council passed a motion for administration to move ahead on the design of a multi-sport field (dome).

On October 22, 2019, Administration presented a project update to the Priorities Committee that provided an overview on the following elements: needs assessment and stakeholder engagement, site analysis, construction method evaluation, functional facility areas, and operating and capital budget estimates. Administration also provided a timeline and overview for the next phase of planning to occur in 2020.

With the recent COVID-19 situation, the planning timeline has been revised. Administration will provide the Priorities Committee with a project overview on the following elements: fieldhouse concept and design, project timeline, community group engagement results, and the capital budget review. In addition, administration will outline the next phase of planning that includes resident engagement, economic impact assessment, operating budget development and site assessment.
